# From the Secretary's Desk... Rt. Wor. Robert W. Carpenter, Jr.

How well do you know the Declaration of Independence? If you are like most Americans, there are several things about the Declaration that go unnoticed, or just unknown.

On July 4, 1776, the Second Continental congress officially adopted the Declaration of Independence. Most of the delegates signed the Declaration on August 2, 1776, with five signing on a later date. Two delegates never signed at all. The signed copy resides at the National Archives in the Rotunda for the Charters of Freedom, alongside the Constitution and the Bill of Rights.

Thanks to the movie "National Treasure", the character played by Nicholas Cage convinced many people that there is something written on the back of the Declaration. But, guess what? There is. Written upside-down across the bottom of the signed document is: "Original Declaration of Independence dated July 4<sup>th</sup> July 1776". Do we know who wrote this or when? Unfortunately, no.

When a copy of the Declaration arrived in New York City by July 9, 1776, it caused a riot. After it was read to the crowd by Bro. George Washington, a statue of King George III was torn down, and subsequently melted and shaped into 42,000 musket balls. A fitting return on the British investment.

Of the 56 signers, eight were born in Britain. Two in England, one in Wales, two in Scotland, two in Ireland, and one in Northern Ireland. There was a 44 year age difference between the youngest and the oldest signers. The oldest being Bro. Benjamin Franklin (age 70), the youngest was Edward Rutledge (age 26).

Of the hundreds of copies printed on the night of July 4, 1776, only 26 survive, but since being housed in Washington D.C., has the original always resided there? No. On December 23, 1941, the signed Declaration, together with the Constitution, were evacuated from Washington D.C., and were transported under heavy guard and stored in Fort Knox, Kentucky. It was returned to Washington in 1944.

How much is one of the copies worth? One was located in Philadelphia in 1989 by a man who found it in the back of a picture frame he bought for \$4. It later sold for \$8.1 million in 2000. Have you bought any old picture frames lately?
