I remember the times when we had almost every seat filled. What on earth has happened to our membership? Well, I know some of them got angry about building expenses for renovations. Aren't we supposed to be about more than that?

What about the brethren who work at all the businesses in town? Ah, I remember now. Some left when the merger took place, and instead of leaving quietly, he took a bunch of brothers with him. They didn't like our new name. I thought our good works mattered more than the name we gave our Lodge.
