Over time, I manage to accumulate many little tidbits of Masonic knowledge. Not only from attendance at Blue Lodges, but from many, many communications that I receive. I guess it is time to let you all in on some of the interesting little "tidbits" that find their way onto my desk. If I can't finish them all this month, there will be more in the coming months.

In 2015, across the United States, there were 3 Worshipful Masters of their respective Lodges that were age 93 or over. The Worshipful Masters of Virginia Lodge No. 544 in Virginia, Illinois and Gwinnett Daylight Lodge No. 744 in Lawrenceville, GA were both 93 last year while serving the Craft. The oldest, however, was the Worshipful Master of a Lodge in Alabama and installed on his 97th birthday.

You can go to www.massfreemasonry.org, the website of the Grand Lodge of Massachusetts, and view the contents of a time capsule sealed on July 4, 1795. Grand Master Paul Revere layed the corner stone of a new state house in Massachusetts at the request of Governor Samuel Adams. The contents were in excellent condition after more than two centuries.
