### From the Secretary's Desk... Rt. Wor. Robert W. Carpenter, Jr.

Wow! June already! The Masonic year is half over and we have so much left to accomplish. I'm sure Worshipful Butch has great plans for the remainder of this Masonic year.

However, let's look at the month of June. Two days stand out on the calendar. Flag Day and Father's Day. They are a week apart and both fall on a Sunday this year. Both are worthy of mention and since Flag Day falls on the 14<sup>th</sup>, we'll start with that one.

Writers and speakers have long strained their talents in attempting to present, with that special something, what we call Americanism. What exemplifies Americanism? Our Flag, the Fourth of July, Baseball, Apple Pie, Free Elections, the Right to Assemble, and many other great definitions.

Americanism, like our Masonic Fraternity, really deals with profound ingredients of the spirit – a basic decency, a certain faith, a belief in the quality of people, and a respect for the individual.

As we face the Flag of our Great Nation, each with our right hand over our heart, let us consider what our Flag really represents. It is just possible that the word F-L-A-G is an acronym for the words Faith, Love, America, and God.

Father's Day falls one week later on the 21<sup>st</sup>. Originating in 1910 in Spokane, WA, Father's Day did not become a national holiday until many years later. The idea for an official Father's Day celebration was the idea of a daughter whose attention was focused on a sermon on Mother's Day – two years after the first Mother's Day observance in West Virginia. She and her siblings were raised by their Father, and she felt that the hardships he had endured – as well as the unsung feats of fathers everywhere – should be recognized as well. A celebration was organized on the third Sunday in June 1910 and newspapers across the country carried stories about the observance.

Although not so quickly accepted as the celebration of Mother's Day, President Woodrow Wilson and his family observed Father's Day in 1916, and in 1924 President Calvin Coolidge recommended that the states hold their own Father's Day celebrations. The Congressional Record reveals the following entry: "Either we honor both our parents, mother and father, or let us desist from honoring either one. But to single out just one of our parents and omit the other is the most grievous insult imaginable." Eventually, in 1972 – sixty-two years after it was proposed – Father's Day was permanently established by President Richard Nixon.
