From the Secretary's Desk... Rt. Wor. Robert W. Carpenter, Jr.

Continuing with this year's theme of relating the months of 2016 to Masonry, we come upon the month of March. The name of March comes from the Latin Martius, the first month of the earliest Roman calendar. It was named for Mars, the Roman god of war, who was also regarded as a guardian of agriculture. It is one of seven months that are 31 days long. In the northern hemisphere, March 1st is the first day of meteorological spring. The March equinox, which marks the astronomical beginning of spring in the northern hemisphere, occurs this year on March 20th.

Easter this year falls on March 27th and is one of the moveable feasts. By moveable we mean that Easter can fall anywhere between March 22nd and April 25th. How does that work? It's really very simple. Easter is the Sunday following the full moon which falls on or after the previously mentioned equinox. If you check this year's calendar, the equinox being on March 20th and the full moon occurring on March 23rd, means that the following Sunday, or March 27th, is Easter.

So how does March relate to or have anything to do with Masonry? As was noted, Mars, for which March was named, was also the guardian of agriculture. Each and every one of us needs to be constantly aware of those good men around us who are not Masons. We each need to be actively involved in the agriculture of growing new Master Masons. March is a wonderful time to start bringing in those Petitions that will help to keep Tuckahoe Lodge from dying on the vine. Brethren, we need new members and the only way to cultivate those Petitions, is for you to get out ask your friends, neighbors, and family who are not Masons, "Why haven't you ever joined a Masonic Lodge?" Maybe those seeds will grow and the agriculture of March will bring a much needed crop for Tuckahoe Lodge.
