It's the eighth month of the year in both the Julian and Gregorian calendars, and one of seven months that are 31 days long, and is a part of the two pairs of months that are 31 days long consecutively. It was originally named Sextilis (sixth month) in Latin, since it was the sixth month in the ancient Roman calendar. The name was changed to August in honor of Augustus Caesar in the year 8 BC.

The birth flower is the gladiolus or poppy which represents strength, beauty, love, marriage and family. The birthstone is an onyx. It is also the month with the highest birth rate in the US. Coincidentally, it is also the month with the greatest number of brethren being raised in Tuckahoe Lodge. Some of the observances taking place in August include: National Lawn Games Month, National Back to School Month, National Goat Cheese Month, Catfish Month and Sandwich Month. It also includes the Perseid Meteor Shower, International Clown Week, National Mustard Day, and National Underwear Day.


