September heralds the opening of our schools for another year of study and thought provoking instruction. Please watch out for our school children as you are driving around the area.

We are also looking at the ninth month of the year in the Julian and Gregorian calendars. Gee, time really flies when you are having fun. Our officers are looking forward to the completion of another Masonic Year. September, however, is one of four months with a length of 30 days, none of which are consecutive. September 1<sup>st</sup> is the start of meteorological autumn (or fall as many of us call it). This was originally the 7<sup>th</sup> month of the year in the Roman calendar when there were only ten months in a year.
