December – the most happiest time of the year. But what about December? This brings us to the end of my articles about the months of the year. Finally! December, however, has a lot to offer. As its name suggests, December was once the tenth month of the year in the days of the Roman calendar. which was only ten months long and started with March.

It stayed the tenth month until around 700 BC when Nuna Pompilius, the second King of Rome, added two additional months. They became January and February, moving December to the twelfth month but leaving the name the same. It has remained that way through both the Julian and Gregorian calendars. December starts on the same day of the week as September every year and ends on the same day as April every year. It is the month with the shortest daylight hours in the Northern Hemisphere.

December 1<sup>st</sup> marks the beginning of meteorological winter, which consists of the three months December, January, and February. Astronomical winter, however, is based on when the sun reaches the Tropic of Capricorn, which in 2016 is December 21<sup>st</sup>.

Some interesting observances in December include International Hug Day on the 4<sup>th</sup>, Monkey Day on the 14<sup>th</sup>, Forefathers' Day on the 22<sup>nd</sup> celebrated in Plymouth, MA, and of course those two famous holidays – Christmas Day on the 25<sup>th</sup> and New Year's Eve on the evening of the 31<sup>st</sup>.
