Happy 4<sup>th</sup> of July! Happy Birthday America! Happy Masonic birthday to all our July birthday Master Masons listed in this bulletin!

I was thinking recently about a portion of the Master's short prayer at the opening of a Lodge when no Chaplain is present. It goes something like this: ...may this meeting thus begun in order, be conducted in peace, and closed in harmony. Let us briefly look at these three parts.

ORDER – we think of a system where things are arranged systematically so that we know where to find any part we might happen to be looking for without too much trouble.

PEACE – a quietness of the intellect, and a oneness with each other and with God.

HARMONY – a combination of pleasing effects that tend to give a meeting a feeling of well-being.

These three factors are what we may call the essence of a builder's art. Their use gives us a feeling of security and a joy that we do not find without them. Our faculties are sharpened by their use in ritual. We need to learn and inwardly digest what we hear in Masonic ritual. Take any phrase in our ritual and from it, one can build within his own thoughts a consciousness of belonging to something that requires considerable time and attention to interpret. Small things sometimes require considerable thought. Hearing, seeing, and feeling become more real, and our search for light becomes more clear simply because we open our Communications in Order, conduct them in Peace, and close in Harmony.

All Masonic gatherings, brethren, should be based upon these three principles. If we do that, we cannot fail to further our Masonic teachings among our brethren and among the world.
