How many of you know the Order of DeMolay Motto? How many of you were members of this outstanding young man's organization when you were between the ages of 14 (at that time and now 12) and 21? Founded by Bro. Frank S. Land in Kansas City, MO in 1919, the success and popularity of the original DeMolay chapter spurred members to set up chapters across the country.

When Frank Land passed away in 1959, there were 135,000 DeMolay members and 2,097 chapters in 14 countries. Local chapters are sponsored by a Masonic or Appendant Body. Their rituals were written in the early 1920s by Bro. Frank Marshall, a drama and music critic for The Kansas City Journal, and they continue to today.

The DeMolay emblem depicts the history and ritual elements of the Order. It features a crown of youth with a five armed white cross, ten rubies, a knight's helmet, a crescent surrounded by stars, and a pair of crossed swords. The ten rubies, a continual symbol in the Order, represent the nine original DeMolay members and founder Frank S. Land. The rubies were originally depicted as pearls and when each of the original founders died, a pearl was changed to a ruby. There are currently DeMolay International Chapters in more than 15 countries worldwide.

But....back to my original question. Do you know the Order of DeMolay Motto? Can you live up to this Motto? Every Mason (whether you were a DeMolay or not) should strive every day to fulfill these expectations.

"No DeMolay shall fail as a citizen, as a leader and as a man."					

And, yes, it's that time of year again. Dues notices will be going out shortly. Our dues will remain the same for 2018 – \$100 (\$89 for those 70 years of age and over).
