#### VIRTUES WE SHOULD LIVE BY

What, you say, is a virtue? It is, simply put, a habitual and firm disposition to "do good". The four Cardinal Virtues you learned about in the Entered Apprentice Degree are the four principal moral virtues. Temperance, Fortitude, Prudence and Justice.

Temperance represents restraint. The Mason must control his passions and desires. He must exercise caution in his action, speech, thought, feeling, judgment and life. Fortitude symbolizes more than physical courage. It also represents moral courage. The Mason must have the strength and ability to make a decision based upon his own moral convictions and stick to it. Prudence should be the peculiar characteristic of every Mason, not only for the government of his conduct while in the Lodge, but also when out in the world. It implies not only caution but also the ability to judge in advance the probable consequences of one's actions. Justice is not only consistent with Divine and human laws, but is the very cement and support of civil society. It constitutes the really good man, and should be the practice of every Mason never to deviate from the excellent principles it symbolizes.

Living by the Cardinal Virtues will bring to each of us honor, and a reputation that is untarnished. In our Lodges, as long as we govern ourselves by using the four Cardinal Virtues as a guide, then we will continue to stand the test of time.
