JAMES CASH PENNEY - MASTER MASON

James Cash Penney was born in 1875 in Hamilton, MO. His first paying job was in a general store for \$2.27 a month. According to written records of his success, it was because of his basic philosophy in dealing with people and the principle of the Golden Rule. He died in 1971. In 1940, during a visit to a store in Des Moines, lowa, one of the young men he trained was named Sam Walton (Ever hear of him? Yes! That Sam Walton).

J.C. Penney became a member of Wasatch Lodge No. 1 in Salt Lake City in 1911. In 1945 he became a 33rd Degree Scottish Rite Mason and in 1958 he received a Gold Distinguished Service Award from Royal Arch Masonry. He typically wore a large Masonic ring showing his pride of being a Mason.

His stores, which have been in business for more than 118 years, have been the subject of news articles related to the filing of bankruptcy. Let's not focus on the financial condition, or on the COVID-19 pandemic, but on the man as a Mason. His entire philosophy was based on fairness and providing the best value for a customer's dollar. He originally called his stores –

"The Golden Rule Stores", but had to change the name to the J.C. Penney Company due to other stores using the same name. He put the Golden Rule into action and turned it into success.

As a Mason, you should take to heart the teachings and philosophy of this 96-year-old Masonic Giant (when he passed away). His humanitarian projects and philanthropies have outlived him, and continue to this day. Your Masonic teachings and the lessons you have learned in the Masonic Degrees, are reflected in the way James Cash Penney lived his life for all mankind. Make sure your actions (which speak louder than words) continue to reflect his teachings and philosophies.
