There is no such thing as a proof of a belief which has no evidence; therefore, man cannot "prove God" in the same way in which he can "prove" an algebraic equation. Faith is a matter of the heart; geometry is a matter of the mind. But there is a meeting point where mind and heart touch. And there is a meeting point where faith and science touch.
