

RESOLUTION FOR CONSOLIDATION WITH TUCKAHOE LODGE

The following Resolution requiring acceptance by Tuckahoe Lodge No. 347 was balloted upon for the 1st time at our May Stated Communication and will be called up for a 2nd ballot at our June Stated Communication.

Whereas, the brethren present at a Stated Communication of the Lodge of Strict Observance No. 207 in the summer of 2006 voted unanimously to explore consolidation with another Lodge, and

Whereas, a committee was formed and investigated 3 Lodges for consolidation, and

Whereas, the majority of the brethren present at the December 18, 2006 Stated Communication voted to consolidate, and

Whereas, the majority of the brethren present at the March 19, 2007 Stated Communication of the Lodge of Strict Observance voted on a ballot to consolidate with Tuckahoe Lodge No. 347,

Therefore, be it resolved, that the Lodge of Strict Observance No. 207 consolidate with Tuckahoe Lodge No. 347.

The members of both Tuckahoe Lodge and the Lodge of Strict Observance are balloting on this Resolution. The Lodge of Strict Observance took their 1st ballot at their April Stated Communication. This resulted in an unanimous ballot in favor of consolidation. Tuckahoe Lodge took their 1st ballot at their May Stated Communication. This resulted in an unanimous ballot in favor of consolidation.

The Resolution will be read for a 2nd time for ballot at the May Stated Communication of the Lodge of Strict Observance and the June Stated Communication of Tuckahoe Lodge. Both of these ballots must result in a 75% majority in order to pass.


