

Those of you who are asked to participate on an investigating committee must realize that this is an important function of the lodge, and must be handled in a professional manner. Remember brethren, a proper investigation is part of the first step in the Petitioner's process of becoming a Mason. As such, it will always be remembered by the Petitioner.
