

BY-LAWS

Tuckahoe Lodge No. 347 **A.F. & A.M.**
Richmond, **Virginia**

ARTICLE I

The stated communications of this Lodge shall be held at the Masonic Temple 5500 Bethlehem Road, Richmond
Virginia on the First Thursday of Each Month
at 7:15 PM o'clock.

ARTICLE II

Every member of this Lodge except the Treasurer, Secretary, Tiler, and one Chaplain
shall be charged by the Secretary with the sum of Sixty-Five Dollars plus Grand Lodge dues and assessments
as Annual dues. Does the Lodge use a COLA to determine its dues? Yes No X

ARTICLE III

The total fees for the degrees in this Lodge, including that amount which must accompany the petition, shall be One Hundred Seventy
Dollars, payable as follows:
Fifty Dollars for the Degree of Entered Apprentice; and
Fifty Dollars for the Degree of Fellowcraft; and
Fifty Dollars for the Degree of Master Mason; and
Twenty Dollars shall accompany the petition.

A non-refundable Criminal Background Check fee shall also accompany the petition, the cost of which shall be determined by the office of the Grand Secretary.

ARTICLE IV

The Treasurer shall receive an annual compensation of Five Hundred Eighty Dollars,
payable in Quarterly installments.

ARTICLE V

The Secretary shall receive an annual compensation of Five Hundred Eighty Dollars,
payable in Quarterly installments.

ARTICLE VI

The Tiler, or Acting Tiler, shall receive a compensation of Twenty Dollars
for each communication he attends in that capacity.

ARTICLE VII

The Three Trustees, who shall be recommended by the Lodge and appointed by the Court having jurisdiction, shall at each annual
stated communication in December make a report of the investment of all funds and condition of property entrusted to their care.

ARTICLE VIII

Any amendment proposed to these by-laws must be submitted in writing at a stated communication, lie over the required four weeks,
the membership be notified, and shall require a Two-Thirds affirmative vote of the members present for its adoption.
