Tuckahoe History

- July 2013 - Bro. Chris Geary presents a time capsule to the Lodge, which is placed in our Library. It was filled with various items and sealed in February 2014. It is to remain sealed until our 125th anniversary, on February 14th, 2048.
- 2015 - A new sign placed in our driveway sharing details of our Lodge and tenants.
- 2018 - Our bike program with Johnson Elementary School next door spins up. This program grew from a small donation to now over \$1000 a year to purchase bikes for outstanding students each quarter.
- October 2018 - Tuckahoe creates a Facebook account to reach out to members as well as share its activities with the world online. Shortly thereafter, Brothers from Brazil and Ireland find us and visit the Lodge while in town.
- 2019 - Tuckahoe moves to District 15-A (from 15-C).
- Starting mid March 2020 - First time in our 100 year history we were unable to hold Stated (or any other meetings) by order of the Grand Lodge of Virginia due to the COVID-19 Pandemic. Limits on attendance and other guidelines were in place into 2021.
- Tuckahoe moved to regular Zoom meetings to allow Brethren to meet, check on the welfare of Brethren, and enjoy each others company.
- Mid 2021 removed the various limitations on Lodge attendance. The Lodge held a 'Rally Day' in where over 80 attended to enjoy each others company.
- February 2023 - Tuckahoe celebrates 100 years of Masonic Light. Celebrations are held throughout the year including a Table Lodge, special events, and a review of our history. Flags were flown in honor of the Lodge at the State Capital and Grand Lodge of Virginia. The original Bible gifted to the Lodge in 1923 was used for each of our Stated Meetings.
